■ **New Delhi, Sept. 11:** State-owned Ircon has won the contract to build a second railway bridge over the Meghna river at Bhairab in Bangladesh. The 982.20-metre bridge will be built from the \$1-billion Indian line of credit. Construction work will end in 30 months at a cost of around Rs 485 crore, the state-owned firm said.

A JV of Indian Railways PSU Ircon and infrastructure major Afcons has signed a contract agreement with Bangladesh Railway for the work of a Railway Bridge with approach rail lines. This project involves doubling of Dhaka-Chittagong railway corridor, the backbone of Bangladesh railway infrastructure. The project, costing BDT 567 crore, is targeted to be completed in 30 months.
